

“Unibear” Questions & Suggested Scripture Answers for Discussions

Q: Why do you think the author chose a butterfly to lead the bear into the dark woods?

Discuss the Chrysalis...

[2 Corinthians 5:17](#) Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the **new creation** has come: The old has gone, the **new** is here!

Q: Why do you think the author used the symbolism of ‘dark woods’?

[Psalm 23:4](#) Even though I walk through the **darkest** valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

[John 8:12](#) When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the **light** of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in **darkness**, but will have the **light** of life.”

[John 12:46](#) I have come into the world as a **light**, so that no one who believes in me should stay in **darkness**.

Q: A ray of light shined down on the horse, what was the symbolism?

[John 1:5](#) The **light** shines in the **darkness**, and the **darkness** has not overcome it.

[1 John 1:5](#) This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is **light**; in him there is no **darkness** at all.

Q: What did the horse do when he felt all was lost?

[1 Thessalonians 5:16-18](#) Rejoice always, **pray continually**, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.

Q: The horse was tied down by a vine, so he prayed. Why?

[Psalm 91:14](#) “Because he loves me,” says the Lord, “I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.

Q: Why was Bear able to see the unicorn’s horn?

[Psalm 70:4](#) But may all who **seek you** rejoice and be glad in you; may those who long for your saving help always say, “The Lord is great!”

[Matthew 5:16](#) In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they **may see your** good deeds and glorify **your** Father in heaven.

Q: When Bear told his friends, why did some believe and others did not?

...when you try to share “the good news” or “spread the word” some will hear and some won’t.

...When you do a good deed do it with no expectations. Do it with a good heart and pure intentions. When others see this they will do the same and start a chain reaction of goodness.

Q: Why do you think Bunny could see a unicorn horn on Bear?

[John 3:36](#) Whoever **believes** in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God’s wrath remains on them.

Q: Once you receive the gold the magic will spread, what is symbolic of this phrase?

[2 Thessalonians 3:1](#) As for other matters, brothers and sisters, pray for us that the **message** of the Lord may **spread** rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you.

Q: The gift is given by something so much higher... representative to...

[2 Corinthians 9:14-15](#) And in their prayers for you their hearts will go out to you, because of the surpassing grace God has given you. Thanks be to God for his indescribable **gift!**

Q: How often must you work for it? What else should you do this often?

[Psalms 61:8](#) So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows

Q: Do you have to help others?

[1 Corinthians 1:9](#) God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

[1 John 1:3](#) That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

Q: What does the story say if everyone does good deeds.

[Matthew 5:16](#) In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your **good deeds** and glorify your Father in heaven.
